

Hoosick Town Board Approves Armory Purchase

In late February the Hoosick Town Board suspended its feasibility of purchasing the National Guard Armory. Supervisor Keith Cipperly told the board that he and Councilman Schmigel had met with the directors of the Hoosick Area Youth Center and they had expressed interest in taking possession of the building.

On March 13, the Town Board approved a motion to purchase the armory from New York State at a cost of \$1. The adoption of the motion drew a round of applause by more than 70 members of the community in attendance.

At a meeting in May, the Town Board voted unanimously to adopt a resolution in support of the Youth Center Coalition taking possession of the building.

On October 29, officials from New York State notified HAYC3 (Hoosick Armory, Youth Center and Community Coalition) that the deed transfer had been successful following approval of special legislation.
