“How to Make an American Quilt” is the story of Finn Todd (Winona Ryder), a bride-to-be, who hears the tales of romance and sorrow from her elders as they construct a quilt. She is a young graduate student and preparing for marriage to her fiancé Sam. But thoughts of the end of the single life intrude and she goes home to visit her grandmother. There, over the making of her wedding gift by a group of quilting-bee friends, laughter, bickering, love, and advice lead her an understanding of what her future holds.
